

ORDINANCE- 2024-01

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, IDAHO,
SETTING FORTH A LIMITATION ON SEWER CONNECTIONS
AND LIMITING PERMITS TO TWO (2) PER YEAR GRANTED
ON A FIRST IN TIME PRIORITY BASIS; WAIVING THE RULE
THAT THIS ORDINANCE BE READ ON THREE SEPARATE
OCCASIONS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF
THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING ANY LAWS IN CONFLICT.

WHEREAS the City has determined there is a sewer capacity issue due to the amount of winter storage for sewage in the City; and

WHEREAS the City finds the sewer capacity issue to be an imminent peril to the public health, safety and welfare of the Citizens as the City cannot meet the standards for storage of sewage and the increasing demand due to the growing number of residences requesting the same;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Pursuant to Idaho Code 50-301 et. seq., the City of St. Charles, Idaho hereby imposes a limitation on new sewer connections within the City to two (2) per year. The issuance of sewer connection permits shall be granted on a first come, first served basis. The commencement of the aforesaid limitation shall be the date of the passage of this ordinance.

Section 2: The City waives the multiple readings of this Ordinance.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in force as of the date of passage.

Section 4: Any City ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
